

## Resources Available from the Cincinnati Ethics Center:

### 1. High School Ethics Bowl Resources

#### a. Coaches and Mentors

If your school wants to sponsor an ethics bowl teams, but requires assistance with coaching and mentorship, we can help find a qualified coach, most likely one of our award-winning UC collegiate ethics bowl students or graduate intern.

#### b. Coaches Training and Professional Development

If you already have a coach from your school, we offer startup workshops and on-going one-on-one workshops to help high school ethics bowl coaches better meet the needs of their students.

#### c. Student Workshops

We will work directly with your students via a series of workshops that are tailored to meet your needs and interests. Workshops can be scheduled during the school year and during the summer.

### 2. High School Ethics in the Classroom

In addition to resources for ethics bowl, we assist with respect to engaging students in your classroom on ethics related topics that are relevant to the subject area. Services include a team from the Ethics Center visiting your class, but also professional development workshops for high school teachers who plan to lead their own conversations.
